Welcome to Delware State Park. Please follow all state park guidelines to help make everyone's stay safe and fun.

Check-in -3PM. All camping units must be backed in. If you wish to check-in early, please reserve an extra night prior to arrival.

Check-out -1PM Campsites; 11AM Cabins. All camping equipment and vehicles must be removed from the site by 1 PM, or by 11 AM for cabins. If you wish to extend your stay, please reserve an extra night prior to check-out.

Campsites. All campsites may be reserved by visiting reserveohio.com or by calling 1-866-644-6727. No walk-ins are offered.

Golden Buckeye Card holders (or other discount card) will be asked to show their card and identification upon check-In. Cardholders must be present to receive the discount.

Registration Age. No person under the age of 18 may camp in or stay in a cabin unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Length of Stay/Number of People per Site. Maximum stay is 14 nights within a 30-day period. Six (6) people per site maximum.

Tent Camping. No more than two tents per site, w/o recreational vehicle or one tent per site with recreational vehicle. All camping units must be 5 feet apart and camp only in the designated areas, not in or beyond the tree line.

Alcohol. Alcohol is permitted at your rented campsite only. All other Ohio Revised Code rules about intoxicating beverages apply.

Parking. Please do not park on the grass. Campsites are permitted to have a maximum of TWO vehicles. Boat trailers and campers are included as vehicles. One boat trailer per site is permitted. Please consider parking your trailer at the ramp parking lot or at the visitor's lot. Visitors may be in the campground until 10:00 p.m. Only registered campers permitted. All guests must park in designated areas.

Visitors/Quiet Hours. Visitors are NOT permitted in the campground between 10PM and 7 AM. Registered campers are responsible for maintaining quiet hours between 10PM and 7AM.

Gray Water. Dish water must be disposed of in wastewater drains or dump station. No solids to be dumped in wastewater drains.

Black Water. Toilet wastewater must be disposed of at the waste dump station. Full hook up sites have this capability as well.

Pets. Two pet maximum (domestic cats or dogs) per site. Pets ARE NOT permitted on the beach, in the cabins, or in any of the camp buildings. Pets must always be on a leash and NEVER left unattended.

Collecting. Collecting plants or the cutting or gathering of trees or dead wood is against the law.

Fire Rings. Keep all fires contained to fire rings. Do not remove fire rings from their designated locations. Smokeless fire pits must be contained to the fire ring area and are not permitted in the grass.

Swimming. A beach is located inside the park. Swimming permitted in designated areas only. No inflatables.

Firearms/Fireworks. No firearms, fireworks or drones in the camp areas.

Trash and Recycling. Please respect your state park and help protect Ohio's natural resources. Do not leave trash in the fire rings or on your site. Dumpsters are located at numerous locations throughout the campground for your convenience. Do not burn household trash in fire pits. There is also a recycling dumpster in the Visitor Parking lot next to the Camp Store/Check in. Recycle Dumpster is available for cardboard, paper, glass and plastic. No plastic bags.

Bikes. No riding bikes after dark without proper lighting. All bikes must obey all traffic laws.

No Unlicensed/Motorized Vehicles. Nonregistered motor vehicles, such as electric scooters, Segway, hoverboards, dirt bikes, fourwheelers, etc., are not permitted. Drones are not permitted in the park.

Inclement Weather. In the case of a severe storm, please go to the nearest restroom or shower house building for shelter.
